Statuses

- Current:** Current status of the emergency department.
- ECMO Availability:** If an extracorporeal Membrane Oxygenation unit is available for patients.
- ED Boarding:** Holding patients in ED, after admission for inpatient care, but no beds are available
- ED:** ED availability.
- CritCare-ICU:** The number of available ICU/Critical Care beds in the hospital.
- Peds bed:** The number of available pediatric beds in the hospital.

HAvBed

- Emergency Department:** Number of available ED beds.
- Burn Care:** Number of available burn beds.
- Pediatric:** Number of available medical surgical beds for patients 17 and younger.
- Pediatric ICU:** Number of Beds that can support critically ill/injured patients, including ventilator support for patients 17 and younger.
- Neonatal ICU:** Number of beds that provides constant nursing and continuous cardiopulmonary and other support for severely ill infants.
- Peds ICU:** As for Adult ICU, but for patients 17 years and younger.
- Peds:** Ward Medical/Surgical beds for patients 17 and younger.

Bed Capacity

- Bed Capacity: Emergency Department:** Total number of staffed ED beds.
- Bed Capacity: Pediatric:** Total number of staffed pediatrics beds. These are ward medical/surgical beds for patients 17-years-old and younger.
- Bed Capacity: Pediatric ICU:** Total number of staffed pediatric ICU beds. Similar to adult ICU beds, but for patients 17-years-old and younger.
- Bed Capacity: Neg Pressure Isolation:** Total number of staffed negative airflow isolation beds. These provide respiratory isolation. NOTE: This value may represent available beds included in the counts of other types.
- Bed Capacity: Neonatal ICU:** Total Number of staffed Neonatal ICU beds. These are beds that provide constant nursing and continuous cardiopulmonary and other support for severely ill infants.

Influenza Like Illness Data Collection

- Number of ILI Pediatric ICU:** Any person with pneumonia, fever (temperature of 100°F [37.8°C] or greater), cough, and/or a sore throat in the absence of a KNOWN cause other than influenza in a pediatric intensive care unit able to support critically ill/injured patients 17 years and younger, including ventilator support.
